<b>Language and Questioning</b>	Have a look at the examples of calendars... have you seen anything like these before? Where? What are they used for? Talk about significant events in the children's lives and when they occur e.g Christmas, Diwali, Eid, birthdays  Calendar, day, month, year, celebrations, special,	Spend some time looking at the card examples. When have you given/received cards? Talk about cards given at Christmas or during other celebrations. Invite the children to make a card (Christmas or other) - what would you like to use? What would you like to write inside?  Celebration, card, special, give, receive, send, post, message,	Show a picture of Showcase cinema. Has anyone been to the cinema before? What do you do there? Do you need to take anything with you? What do you need to get in? Support the children to count out the coins to buy a ticket and snack.  Cinema, film, ticket, snack, coin, money, pay, how much, count,	Support the children to design and make chosen crafts. What will you need? How can you...? Do you remember when we...? Could that help you now?  Celebration, decoration, Christmas tree, bunting, tear, rip, scrunch, cut, collage, stick, dribble, mix
